



Acceptable Voter Identification

In the upcoming Richmond Hill Municipal Election being held on Monday, October 25, identification will be required in order to receive a ballot from election officials.

As outlined in section 52 (1) 1 ii of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, eligible electors must present the prescribed proof of identity and residence or complete an application in the prescribed form, including a statutory declaration that he or she is the elector shown on the voters' list. This poster provides examples of the types or combinations of acceptable identification.

ONE PIECE OF ID:

Showing Name, Qualifying Address and Signature

- Ontario Driver's Licence
- Ontario Health Card (photo card with address)
- Ontario motor vehicle permit (plate portion)
- Mortgage, lease or rental agreement
- Insurance policy
- Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
- Document issued or certified by a court in Ontario
- Any other document from the Government of Canada, Province of Ontario or a municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government
- Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the Indian Act (Canada)

OR

TWO PIECES OF ID:

First Piece of ID Showing Name and Signature

AND

Second Piece of ID Showing Name and Qualifying Address
